

## MANGIAPOLVERE

### Dust-eater

#### DESCRIPTION

This product is classified as a low-foaming neutral concentrated cleaner with an active rate of about 75%.

Mangiapolvere reduces and almost completely eliminates the problem of dust generated by using powder release agent on stamped concrete.

#### APPLICATION

Cleaner for ordinary, industrial floors, repair-shops, stables, slaughterhouses and dairies.

Normal stains: dilute 5 to 10 grams per litre of water

Very dirty stains: dilute 30 to 50 grams per litre of water

If used with floor washing machines, no instructions are required as this product has no corrosive power.

#### **General cleaner for sanitary ware and tiles:**

Dilute 5 to 10 grams per water litre. The product has no fragrance.

#### **To Wash stamped concrete floors**

The product is sprayed on the floor before washing the powder release. Scrub the surface in order to mix the product with the release and then wash thoroughly.

#### **To wash cement substrates:**

This product can be successfully used even in building to wash both manually and mechanically floors, walls, plasters, statues, etc.. by means of a brush or a water jet machine. It can also be used to remove dust from new cement floors. Dilution must be decided from time to time.

#### PACKING AND STORAGE

Mangiapolvere is available in 25 L plastic containers.

Under normal conditions and when properly stored, the shelf life is 2 years

Sensitive to frost.
